I wrote a few lines to Edith last week. I feel so guilty that I don't write to all ^{my} children every week. You know Ruth that I am thinking about you all the time wondering what you are doing. I just been wondering what best plan would be so we could all be together but I better leave it with you - what ever you think best.

Mother wrote to you ^{about} my going to Edith for Thanksgiving but I wish you all could be with us. I wish Edith would have a home large enough to house us all. but I wish Christmas we could all be together if the weather isn't too bad so Ruth I will close for this time.
